





## Wolgan Valley, Australia

NOVEMBER 8 – 9

Located within the UNESCO-listed Greater Blue Mountains Area, this remote valley has been referred to as “Australia’s best-kept secret.” Explore the stunning landscapes on guided nature walks, learn about the rich heritage of the Aboriginal Wiradjuri people with a unique smoking and cleansing ceremony, or discover the best time of day to spot native animals on a wildlife and sundowners tour.

## Sydney, Australia

NOVEMBER 10

## Great Barrier Reef, Australia

Explore the reef's northern reaches where you can snorkel or dive among a vibrant collection of coral and tropical fish. Or opt to venture into the 140-million-year-old Daintree Rainforest, one of Australia's last truly wild areas.
